You are three times more likely to be in a car crash at night. Wearing a seat belt decreases your risk of being seriously injured or killed in a crash by approximately 50%. Officers are on the lookout for unbelted drivers day and night. Drive without a seat belt and a ticket could be the least of your worries.

DELAWARE SEAT BELT LAWS:

- Everyone in the vehicle, including backseat passengers and children, must wear seat belts properly.
- Lap and shoulder belts must be worn and shoulder belts must not be placed behind the back or under the arm.
- Drivers will receive an \$83.50 ticket for the failure of anyone in the vehicle to buckle up.
